



Brass Keyed Padlocks

Our brass padlock range is an entry level padlock and offers a good security level at the larger 40 and 50mm sizes whilst the 30mm is ideal for lockers and the 20mm for luggage and laptop cases.

Each lock is extruded from a solid piece of high quality brass and the hardened steel shackles are chrome plated to give added weatherproofing.

The whole range is also available in keyed-alike format and in long shackle.

Master Key Combination Padlocks

These are the result of 5 years development and testing with schools and gyms across Europe and now in the 3rd incarnation. The padlock is a traditional brass combination lock with either 3 or 4 dials depending on size but with the added advantage of a master key.

The Master Key is designed to be held by the administrator or staff. This removes the need for bolt cutters if a code is forgotten but also allows staff discrete access to inspect lockers and replace the padlock on the same code if necessary. Additionally, once the masterkey has been used, it allows the code to be reset if forgotten or if you simply wish to collect all the locks and then reissue them to a new set of students or staff members. Note that this additional function is only available in the latest models with the MKR reference.

They also have a couple of unique features making them ideal for schools and lockers. Each padlock can be reset to its own code but a locking feature then prevents the numbers from being accidentally turned until the padlock is shut and locked again. This prevents younger pupils from accidentally changing or forgetting the code before they put it back on their locker. Additionally, the reset position can be "locked in", making it easier for younger students to set their own code who may not have the strength to hold the shackle down for more than a few seconds.

Heavy Duty Combination Padlocks

The 4th lock in the brass combination series is a heavy duty 50mm lock featuring a thicker shackle made from hardened steel to resist cutting. The body is extruded from a solid piece of brass making it secure and weather resistant.

We have then coated the brass in a thin layer of laquer to retain a nice colour. This doesn't improve security but will keep it looking good and prevent the brass from oxidising.

The lock also uses a security key for resetting the combination, a feature very useful on medium and high security locks. This means that once the combination is set, only the owner can reset the code rather than anyone who has access.

MC Series Combination Padlocks

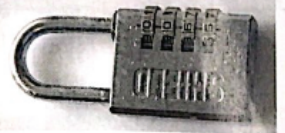
The MC series are fully marine grade combination locks at a much more affordable price than others available on the market. During independent testing by a leading yachting magazine they came out as the most resistant to corrosion in salt water. We purposely kept things simple, without buttons or springs, which make them so reliable whilst keeping cost of manufacture down.

This is described by the suppliers as 'a small and practical rust-free combination padlock by the UK company, Shield. It is simple, easy to use, well priced and exceptionally weather-resistant even in salt water and exposed environments'. It's made out of chromed brass with stainless innards and hasp, and survived our extreme corrosion test in an amazing fashion. After the month it was completely unaffected, its number wheels spun easily and it sprang open without any problems.

MC Series Combination Padlocks

The 155's are an affordable yet reliable padlock for lockers. They deal with the problems associated with cheap combination locks. That being reliability and resistance to picking. We have found many cheap imports can have the codes cracked in perhaps 20-30 seconds using various different techniques. In a school particularly, this is not acceptable, which led us to develop this model.

One thing to stress is that this model has been copied and produced cheaply elsewhere. If it doesn't say "Shield" on the lock then you can assume it is a cheap copy and can't be relied upon.

Note also that some locker latches require the larger 40mm version to work effectively. If in doubt try the smaller size first.
